

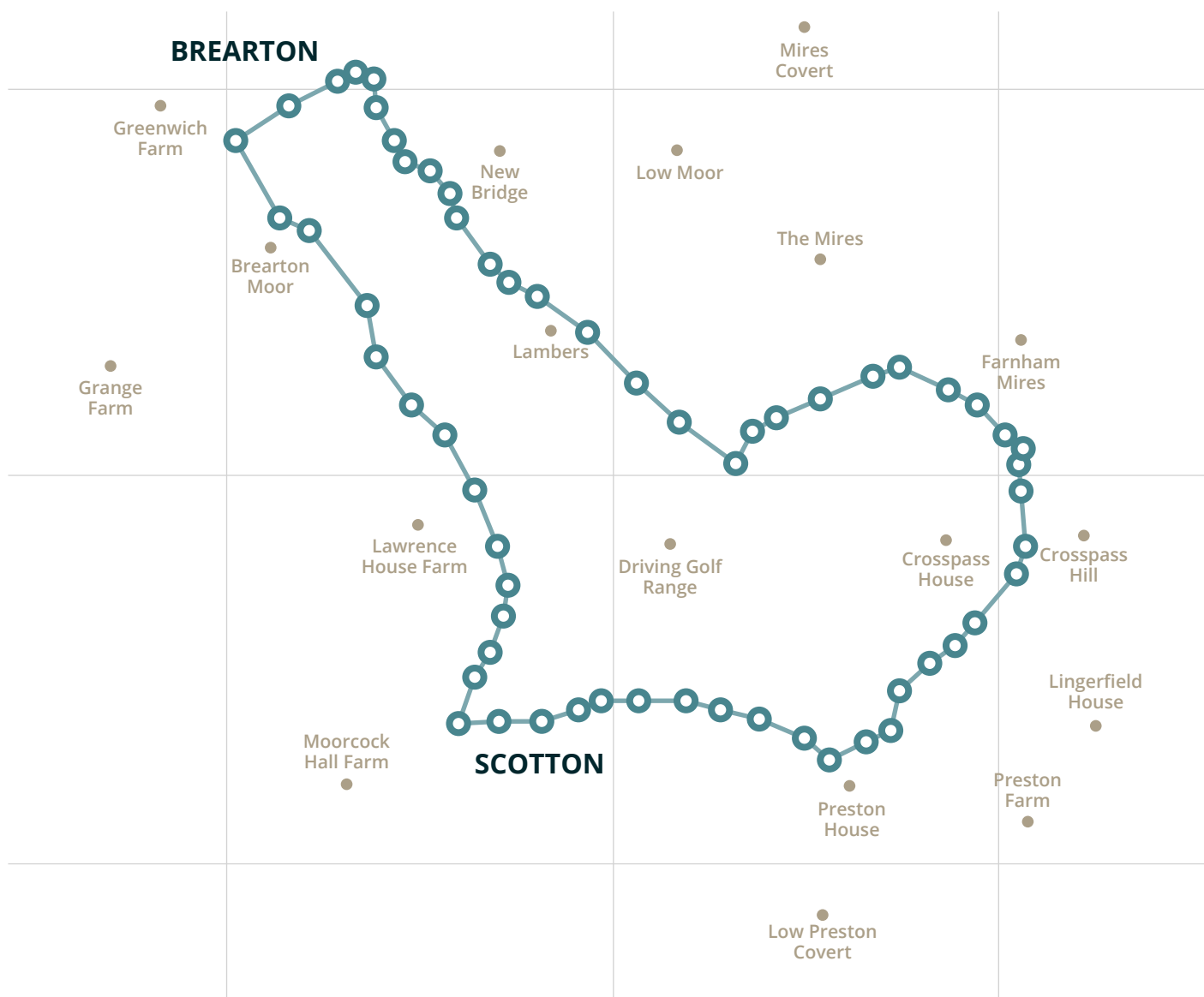

DESCRIPTION

Another circular walk beginning and ending at The Malt Shovel, this route takes you over the fields from Brearton to Scotton, where you pick up the Knaresborough Round way marked route, bringing you back to The Malt Shovel! This route is flatter than Route 1, although it may not seem that way from the route profile!

WALKING GUIDE

1. Turn left up the road from outside The Malt Shovel, heading out of the village.
2. At the top of the rise in the road, there is a stile on the left that takes you onto the footpath towards Scotton.
3. Cross the first field until you find the new gated bridge, then cross Jumwell Beck.
4. Turn diagonally left after the bridge, and a stile is visible. Go over this stile, then take a diagonal route across the next field, aiming towards another stile, with yellow markings on the post.
5. Straight over this and the next stile, and then follow the farm track towards Scotton.
6. Yet another stile, will pop you over the wall in front of a row of cottages, and onto the road side. Turn right, and walk up into the main part of the village.
7. Near a bus stop, there is a clear cut into 'Smithy Lane' signposted 'Knaresborough Round'. Take this path, and follow this ancient lane towards Lingerfield.
8. When you reach the Lingerfield to Scriven road, go straight across, and follow the path around the right hand side of the field, keeping to the edge of the field as the path bears to the left.
9. Go over the stile at the bottom left hand side of the field, and head in between two small ponds, coming to a gate, with a small footbridge. Follow the signs through the gate and over the bridge, then around a residential garden.
10. You reach Stang Lane, and turn left along the road for half a mile.. When next to the school, a path is clear on your right hand side. Take this path, and you will reach a track that becomes a road, that will bring you into the far side of Brearton.
11. Past the Church on your left, and The Malt Shovel is a few minutes walk, with excellent food, drinks and cosy fires.
