

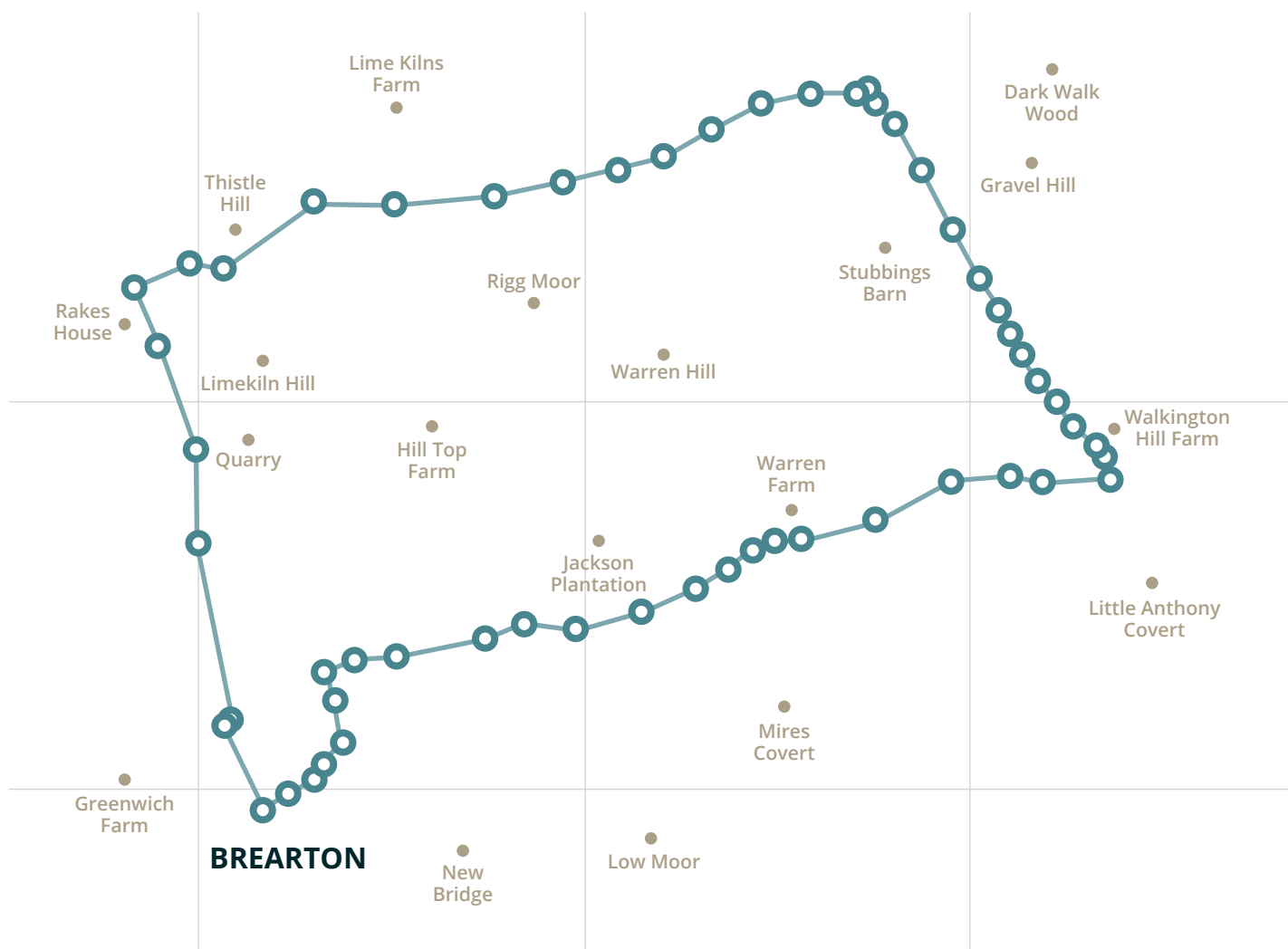

THE MALT SHOVEL

DESCRIPTION

A circular walk around the Mountgarret Estate lanes and farming tracks that surround Brearton. Beginning and ending at The Malt Shovel, this route uses clear pathways and tracks, taking you through farmland, woodland and finally the village of Brearton itself, before returning to the pub for a well-earned meal and a drink!

WALKING GUIDE

1. Set off up the lane directly in front of the pub – Lillygate Lane.
2. Follow the road round briefly to your right, then turn left onto a wide track.
3. Follow this track over Limekiln Hill until you reach Rakes Lane.
4. Turn right onto Rakes Lane, going downhill until you reach a cattle grid (not the one to your left).
5. After the cattle grid, keep following the farmers track through a field that is usually full of sheep. A small beck meanders to your left along the path.
6. At the clear junction in the wood, turn right, and follow the track (Green Lane) upwards.
7. Up and over the hill, with Walkingham Wood to your right, there is a steep descent until you come to a gate and stile on your right. Go over the stile, and follow the path, again with the woods on your right hand side. Look out for Red Kites here, as many nest in the woods.
8. Cross the field, coming to a gate at the end. Follow Warren Lane back towards Brearton, turning left on the road after Hill Top Farm, and come out by the village green.
9. The Malt Shovel with cosy log fires is now 5 minutes walk away, and your lunch awaits!
